

Little Black Pearl Art & Design Academy Lottery Policy

Little Black Pearl Art & Design Academy is not a selective or lottery enrollment high school; however, applications for enrollment are accepted from students residing within the city limits of Chicago (Board of Education District #299). Students entering high school in 9th grade or between the ages of 14-21 years of age are eligible to submit an enrollment application. To be considered for admissions, an enrollment application must be submitted and the admissions criteria must be met. For immediate consideration, complete the online application or call to schedule an appointment to complete an in-person application. Parent/guardian and student must attend an admission orientation.

Admissions Criteria

- Complete a Little Black Pearl Enrollment application online or schedule an appointment to complete your application on-site
- Reside within any City of Chicago zip code
- Parent and student must attend a mandatory admissions orientation meeting
- Enrolled in high school in 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade

Little Black Pearl Art & Design Academy prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability, race, creed, color, gender, national origin, religion, ancestry, marital status, sexual orientation or need for special education services. The application must be completed in its entirety. In addition to the application form, the following information is collected on each applicant and maintained on file:

- Proof of age; Proof of residence;
- ISBE Student Transfer form is from another high school;
- high school transcript, if applicable; and
- current immunization record

All applications will be reviewed. Upon review, parents and potential students will be required to meet with the Dean, Principal or other administrators to meet regarding enrollment, and to understand school and family expectations.
